Invitation to Comment on Standard Contract Form, Credit Terms and Instruments Related to the Procurement of Renewable Energy Credits (“RECs”)

Commonwealth Edison Company (“ComEd”) is procuring Renewable Energy Credits (“RECs”) for the period beginning June 1, 2008. NERA Economic Consulting is the Procurement Administrator.

The Procurement Administrator is proposing as the standard contract form the ABA-EMA-ACORE Master Renewable Energy Certificate Purchase & Sale Agreement with certain modifications and specific terms (“the REC Master Agreement”). The Procurement Administrator has posted the REC Master Agreement to the RFP Web site (www.2008-rfp.com) on Friday, February 1, 2008.

Interested parties are invited to submit their comments on the REC Master Agreement. All Suppliers to ComEd under the terms of the Renewable Energy Resource RFP would sign this REC Master Agreement. All comments received in accordance with the process outlined below will be evaluated by a review committee consisting of representatives from ComEd, the Procurement Administrator, Staff of the Illinois Commerce Commission, and the Procurement Monitor.

The timeline and process for interested parties to provide comments on the REC Master Agreement is as follows:

- The exclusive method for submitting comments is by email. Comments must be submitted by email to Dr. Chantale LaCasse of NERA Economic Consulting, at the following e-mail address: comments@2008-rfp.com. Interested parties are requested to provide telephone and email contact information in the event that the review committee needs clarification regarding their comments.
- A conference call is scheduled for Wednesday, February 13, 2008. This call will begin with a short presentation on the REC Master Agreement, which will be followed by a question period. Please send any call-in information request to comments@2008-rfp.com.
- The deadline for interested parties to provide comments is Wednesday, February 20, 2008, at noon CPT.
- The REC Master Agreement incorporating accepted comments will be posted to the ComEd RFP Web site by Friday, February 29, 2008.
