For purposes of this Act, landfill gas produced in the State is considered a renewable energy resource. "Renewable energy resources" does not include the incineration, burning, or heating of tires, garbage, general household, institutional, and

commercial waste, industrial lunchroom or office waste, landscape waste other than trees and tree trimmings, railroad cross-ties, utility poles, and construction or demolition debris, other than untreated and unadulterated waste wood.
